

## **LASIK Post Op**

You will be given the following eye drops to use in the treated eye(s) on your surgery day:

- Flarex – Four (4) times daily until your one week visit.
- Ciloxan – Four (4) times daily until your one week visit.
- Preservative-free artificial tears (e.g. Tears Naturale II) – use as often as necessary for comfort.

The first drops of each type have already been placed in your eye. Wait ten minutes after placing Flarex drops in your eyes before placing Ciloxan drops. Wait an additional ten minutes before using artificial tears.

- Do not rub your eye(s).
- Following surgery, go home and take a nap.
- You should not have severe pain. Some discomfort and tearing are normal. You may take Extra-Strength Tylenol, ibuprofen, or aspirin every four hours for pain.
- If you experience any discomfort in the treated eye, use ice compresses for 10 minutes every ½ hour as needed.
- Limit strenuous activity for today. You may then resume normal activity. Use protective eyewear for any sports activity.
- Keep all foreign matter away from your eye(s) for two weeks. Do not wear any eye make-up for one week.
- Swimming is restricted for one month following surgery.
- For the first week following your surgery, wear the goggles provided, at bedtime.
- Please wear sunglasses when in bright light.
